- 1 Resolution: 2019-01
- 2 Subject: Cass County Republican Party call for legislation enforcing Congressional performance standards.
- 3 <u>WHEREAS</u>: Article 1, Section 8, Clause 1 of the United States Constitution designates the "power of the purse" as a
- 4 function of Congress.
- 5 <u>WHEREAS</u>: The Federal Budget Process requires the President to submit a federal budget to Congress early each
- 6 calendar year for the coming fiscal year which begins on October first.
- 7 WHEREAS: The Federal Budget Process requires the House and Senate to pass budget resolutions, reconcile
- 8 differences and vote on appropriation bills which can be submitted to the President, where the bills can be signed into
- 9 law or vetoed.
- 10 <u>WHEREAS</u>: The United States Congress has not submitted a complete federal budget in many years.
- 11 WHEREAS: The Executive and Legislative Branches have failed to complete the appropriations process and
- subsequently shut down the Federal Government 21 times since 1976.
- 13 **WHEREAS**: The pay and allowances, of elected and appointed officials in the Executive and Legislative Branches as
- well as Congressional and White House Staffers, are generally not affected by Government shutdowns or furloughs.
- 15 **RESOLVED**, That as a result of the Executive and Legislative failure to perform basic duties outlined in the US
- 16 Constitution and the Federal Budget Process; the Republican Party of Cass County Nebraska, calls on the Nebraska
- 17 Congressional Delegation to draft, sponsor, and ensure passage of legislation requiring all elected and appointed
- 18 members of the Executive and Legislative Branches to forfeit 100 percent of pay and allowances during any year in
- 19 which all appropriations bills are not approved by the first day of the fiscal year (1 Oct). Additionally, legislation must
- 20 require that all pay and allowances, for all Congressional and White House Staffers, be forfeited and not reimbursed,
- during any type of government shutdown. This legislation shall be enduring; without exemptions or sunset provisions.
