Election Integrity Resolution

WHEREAS free and fair elections are essential to preserving our state, our republic, and the many God-given freedoms and liberties we enjoy; and

WHEREAS the ability of American citizens to exercise their right to vote is foundational to our constitutional republic; and

WHEREAS the legitimacy of the American form of government depends on the citizens' widespread confidence in the fairness of elections and acceptance of election results; and

WHEREAS, preserving the integrity of the electoral process is one of our government's most important responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the administration of elections in Nebraska is governed by an extensive set of duly enacted laws; and

WHEREAS, however, election laws are not self-enforcing but rely on the good faith efforts of election officials to dutifully carry out those laws as written in order to ensure fair elections; and

WHEREAS, Nebraskans have serious doubts about the validity of the 2020 US Election and down ballot results; and

WHEREAS, discounting or mocking their concerns is neither an answer nor proper response in our form of government; and

WHEREAS, a full forensic audit of Nebraska's election results and processes for the 2020 US Election will help restore voter trust and fortify election integrity; now, therefore, bet it

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Nebraska Legislature to make laws and to exercise its oversight and investigative authority to determine the extent to which elections in Nebraska have been conducted in compliance with the law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Cass County Republican Central Committee urges the Secretary of State to investigate the election results, focusing on elections conducted after January 1, 2019 and requests the Secretary of State to conduct a full forensic audit of Nebraska's 2020 General Election.
